
What are the qualities of a good leader?

A good leader should have the following qualities:

- Courageous and brave: which means that he or she can face danger without showing fear. He or she will speak up to say if something is wrong. They believe in their ideas and will not leave it because other people threaten them.
- **Listens to people**: They respect other people. They think about other people's feelings. They listen and try to understand what people want before they make a decision.
- **Self-sacrificing:** They are willing to suffer and give up their own comforts for the sake of others.
- Works with a team: a good leader works with other people and gets advice from other people before they make important decisions.
- **Dedicated to their beliefs:** They keep on working for what they believe is right and will defend what they believe in.
- Willing to serve: They are hardworking and they do things to make sure that other people are taken care of before they take care of themselves.
- Honest and trustworthy
- **Kind and caring:** A leader should be friendly and not bully people into following them
