## 2024 – HARTLEY ROAD PRIMARY SCHOOL UNIFORM POLICY

1. The school uniform serves an important social and educational purpose.
2. The adoption of the school's uniform promotes school safety, improves discipline and enhances the learning environment.
3. The school uniform also assists in the early recognition of persons not authorised to enter the school.
4. It helps parents and learners in resisting peer pressure to buy expensive branded clothing.
5. It helps reduce theft, especially of designer clothing, jewellery and expensive footwear.
6. It helps minimize gang violence and gang activity.
7. It helps to instill discipline in learners.
8. Most importantly, it helps learners to concentrate on their school work.

No deviation will be accepted. Learners who default will be sent home to change. Violations will also result in the learners being asked to remove the incorrect items. Parents are advised not to support ill-discipline, as deviations are not allowed, even on an excursion/ Or any school function.

### GRADE R

The uniform is a single uniform, and must be worn on all days.

Girls - School track suit, Grey Little Harts t-shirt, black anklets, grey mini burkahs, strictly plain black Velcro takkies.  
Boys - School track suit, Grey Little Harts t-shirt, black socks, strictly plain black Velcro takkies.

### GRADES 1 - 3

Girls - black tunic & pants set, black anklets, black cardigans, grey mini burkahs (not black), strictly plain black Velcro takkies.  
Boys - school grey longs, white shirt, black pull-over, black socks or A white kurtah and school grey longs or the White Hartley Tshirt with Black Hartley Trackpants, white mosque hat, strictly plain black Velcro takkies. School boy haircut (Machine number 3 to 5), No tinting, No wedges.

\* Plain Black non-branded takkies with only black soles may be worn Mondays to Fridays.

### GRADES 4 - 7

Girls - black cloak set, black anklets, black cardigans, grey burkahs (NO SCARVES), strictly plain black Velcro takkies.  
Boys - school grey longs, white shirt, black pull-over or Hartley Grey kurtah and school grey longs, grey mosque hat, black socks, strictly plain black Velcro takkies. School boy haircut (Machine number 3 to 5), No tinting, No wedges.

School uniforms must be worn Mondays to Fridays.  
On PE days learners are to wear their School Uniforms over their PE Kit.

### PE KIT GRADES 1 – 7

Girls and Boys Hartley track suit only.  
\* Boys must wear the white t-shirt with the school logo, and the girls must wear the black t-shirt with the school logo (not tight-fitting).  
\* Plain Black non-branded takkies with only black soles may be worn Mondays to Fridays.  
\* (soccer boots to be carried separately – no metal studs).

EARRINGS/JEWELLERY/FANCY ALICE BANDS/HAIR CLIPS etc. – NOT ALLOWED – girls are allowed studs only.  
BOYS – NO FANCY HAIRCUTS, School boy haircut (Machine number 3 to 5) – No tinting, No wedges.  
Plain black school bag or Hartley school bag – NO COLOUR OR BRANDED BAGS.
